<b>CHARGE: Violation of Section 4.02 of the Arida Penal Code. Controlled Substance Act</b>					
<p><b>SUMMARY:</b> On January 20, 1998 Officer Shackelford received a report from Confidential Informant (CI) Billy Barrow that suspect was in possession of a quantity of "crank." CI is a student at Andrew Johnson High School who has provided this officer information on prior occasions regarding suspected narcotic violations and on each occasion his information has been proven to be true and correct. In this officer's experience, "crank" is a street name for methamphetamine, a Schedule I Controlled Substance. Based on this tip, reporting officer (RO) went to obtain consent from Susan Turner, the principal of Johnson High School, to search suspect's locker. Pursuant to Section 4.42 of the Education Code, diligent effort was made to locate Ms. Turner, but she was not in her office. The school secretary, Willa Carroll, informed RO that Turner's whereabouts were unknown. In view of the exigent circumstances, including the late hour and easy destructibility of the contraband, the RO left the principal's office to secure the locker area. As RO approached the suspect's locker, accompanied by Kelly Smith and the CI, RO noticed the suspect's locker was slightly ajar. In plain view on the top shelf was a clear plastic baggie containing many white tablets. RO has seen methamphetamines on many occasions and immediately recognized the tablets as contraband. A field test of the tablets was conducted at the scene by RO. The preliminary analysis indicated methamphetamine weighing approximately 28 grams. RO secured the locker and turned the contraband over to the Physical Evidence technician for analysis. RO then waited by the locker for the suspect to return. At approximately 3:45 p.m. on this date, RO placed suspect in custody. After advising suspect of his rights, suspect said, "That's not mine, I don't do crank." Suspect was transported to the Roanoak County Jail. On January 27, 1998, RO received a phone call from Physical Evidence Section Officer K. Gooch that chemical analysis determined the contraband seized to be 27.2 grams of methamphetamine. Street value: \$850.00.</p> <p>Signed: _____ Signature and Badge Number</p>

<b>TESTIMONY</b>
Brief Statement of Each Witness's Testimony – Use Additional Sheet If Necessary
Mary Short will testify that her car was struck by Katie Charles, and that Charles was left of center. Short honked horn and flashed brights to get other driver's attention. Saw something fly through air after the wreck.
Deputy Hicks will testify that he processed the fatality accident in which Frederick Bear was killed. Observed an odor of alcohol on Katie Charles, collected a bottle of Seagram's from the scene. Will describe damage to cars. Has diagram of the scene. Arrested K. Charles on 4-25-92. Dr. Hannah will testify to the cause of death of BEAR. Other injuries to the parties involved. M.J. Ghandi will testify to blood drug, blood alcohol, and alcohol tests. CHARLES is D.U.I. REYNOLDS is above level for D.U.I. BEAR is Below level for D.W.I. SHORT'S results are not available due to breakage of vials. R.L. Smith will testify that the latent prints On the Seagram's bottle might be CHARLES.
DEFENSE TESTIMONY: S. LaBrie will testify that SHORT'S departure time may be inaccurate; however there is a pending lawsuit between LaBrie and SHORT. LaBrie has a previous conviction of sexual battery against a former employee. REYNOLDS May testify that CHARLES' departure time from NOR was inaccurate. Will state that CHARLES had a bottle of alcohol in her trunk. He noted SHORT was driving with her brights on and CHARLES attempted to miss the other car. CHARLES may testify That SHORT had crossed center and caused the accident. CHARLES and REYNOLDS had left NOR just after midnight (4-24-92). May state that SHORT was driving with her brights on.

<b>REMARKS</b>
SHORT has a prior D.U.I. conviction on 2-6-87 from Suffolk County, VA. Several witnesses may not be credible and may not appear. Need detailed explanation of blood alcohol levels from M.L. Ghandi. Need to prove who was left of center.
