A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-361 of the Code of Virginia, relating to crimes against nature.

14 Be it enacted by the YMCA Model General Assembly:
15 1. That § 18.2-361 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
16 § 18.2-361. Crimes Against Nature
17 A. If any person carnally knows in any manner any brute animal, ~~or carnally~~
18 ~~knows any male or female person by the anus or by or with the mouth, or voluntarily~~
19 ~~submits to such carnal knowledge,~~ he or she shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony,
20 ~~except as provided in subsection B.~~
21 B. Any person who carnally knows by the anus or by or with the mouth his
22 daughter or granddaughter, son or grandson, brother or sister, or father or mother
23 shall be guilty of a Class 5 felony. However, if a parent or grandparent commits any
24 such act with his child or grandchild and such child or grandchild is at least thirteen
25 but less than eighteen years of age at the time of the offense, such parent or
26 grandparent shall be guilty of a Class 3 felony.
